"Corbin was only 6 months old when we notice that his ability to move his legs had regressed over time. My husband took him to the pediatrician thinking it could be low muscle tone. I will never forget the call from Jon that day. I answered the phone at work and I could tell in Jon's voice that something wasn't right. He seemed very scared, nervous and fighting back tears to get out the words, "We are on the way to Nationwide Children's Hospital, you should meet us there." An emergency MRI revealed a massive tumor that ran along Corbin's spine. As a parent our sole responsibility is to care for and protect our baby, but we felt so hopeless; there was nothing Jon or I could do to protect Corbin from this. The bell ringing was a very proud moment for us; it was beautiful to be surrounded by loved ones watching Corbin smile and ring the bell, just days before his first birthday. Our first experience at the Dance Marathon was powerful. Corbin couldn't resist the excitement and had to walk the red carpet to give high fives to the thousands of cheering students. What we will always cherish is how much Corbin loves to interact with the students. He loves BuckeyeThon. The BuckeyeThon members, the families involved, and the students participating all have the biggest hearts. We could not be more proud to be involved in such a worthy cause. All the time, effort and money is worth it just to make a difference in a single child's life at Nationwide Children's Hospital. No parent should ever have to watch their child suffer through treatment. No child should ever have to fight a battle against cancer. ANGEL FAMILIES

The BuckeyeThon family program now includes our Angel Families which allow the legacy of children who are no longer physically with us to shine through everything BuckeyeThon does. This program continues to show the urgency of raising funds for pediatric cancer. One of BuckeyeThon's angel children is Lauryn, "Lu," Oliphant. Lu was diagnosed with Acute Myeloid Leukemia in December of 2014. After four rounds of chemotherapy, Lu went into remission in April 2015. A few months later, Lauryn relapsed and started treatment again. She received her bone marrow transplant on March 26, 2016 and fought hard with a positive attitude. Lu passed away on May 5, 2016 at the age of 17, but she lives on every day through her family. Lu's mom, Theresa, said, "We are so blessed for the memories we were able to make and share with her. She displayed courage, strength, faith and hope throughout her entire journey fighting AML." BuckeyeThon is proud to be #LuStrong and a part of the Oliphant family's journey.

BuckeyeThon's Dance Marathon

Is the culminating event of BuckeyeThon's fundraising year, which brings together over 5,700 students, staff members, alumni and community members to champion the patients and families of the Hematology/ Oncology/BMT Unit at Nationwide Children's Hospital and celebrate the year's work For The Kids.

MEMBERSHIP

Morale Captains serve as energetic leaders who are responsible for keeping color teams enthusiastic and active throughout the Dance Marathon. They spend months leading up to the event choreographing and rehearsing a Morale Dance that is showcased throughout the event and orchestrate activities that are inclusive for both our BuckeyeThon Kids and Team Members.

Team Captains serve as the link between BuckeyeThon and all of our Team Members. In addition to acting as fundraising and recruitment resources across campus, our Team Captains gain valuable leadership skills and foster long-term relationships. **Committee Members of General Body:** Our 150 members coordinate all of the event planning, corporate partnerships, financial tracking, public relations, alumni relations, fundraising, and membership programs that BuckeyeThon executes throughout the year.

Team Members make up the vast majority of students involved with BuckeyeThon. Our Team Members fundraise through their personal networks both virtually and in-person. Over the course of the year, Team Members have the ability to attend fun events including our CarnOval, BBQ and BuckeyeThon Fashion Show. Those who raise at least \$250 get the chance to attend BuckeyeThon's annual 24-hour Dance Marathon.
